**CITIZEN'S REVIEW BOARD (CRB) CURRENTLY 2 OPENINGS FOR ALTERNATES**

This is a Disciplinary Review Board. Members volunteering for the CRB must have been a citizen of the Town for at least one (1) full calendar year prior to their application, at least 21 years of age and possess a valid Florida Driver's License or Florida ID. Members must maintain residency within the Town limits throughout the duration of a three (3) year appointment term. Must be able to pass the FDLE criminal background check. Members cannot be related to a Town of Lady Lake employee and cannot be a current or former employee. The FOP approves memberships.

**PLANNING AND ZONING BOARD**

The volunteer members of the Planning and Zoning Board are responsible for reviewing comprehensive planning policies and specific development applications as required by the Town's Land Development Regulations and provide recommendations to the Town Commission on planning and land development related matters. Members must be a resident of the Town of Lady Lake. The Board meets regularly one time per month or as required.

Background Required: Membership shall, whenever possible, include an architect, a business person, an engineer, a general contractor or subcontractor and a realtor or have similar or related experience.

**TREE AND BEAUTIFICATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

Volunteer members of the Tree and Beautification Advisory Committee are responsible for identifying and formulating programs to promote the beautification in the Town through the planting of new trees and the protection of existing trees and to assist with the formulation of a comprehensive tree plan for the Town of Lady Lake. Members must be a resident of the Town of Lady Lake. The Committee meets regularly one time per month or as required.

**PARKS AND RECREATION ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

The purpose of the Parks and Recreation Advisory Committee is for identifying and recommending the needs of our community as related to parks and recreation. Members must be a resident of the Town of Lady Lake. The Committee meets regularly one time per month or as required.

**LADY LAKE LIBRARY BOARD**

The Lady Lake Library Board is an advisory board that regulates and encourages organized activities of the library system operated by the town. The board meets regularly one time per month or as required.

**All applications will remain on file for the full year.**
